Our Elementary School Program

1. Academics

In K-5, our students grow not only in academics, but in faith and social responsibility. We focus on core academics such as math, reading, science, and social studies while integrating foreign language, religion, and service-based community projects. Developing critical thinking skills and practicing rigorous problem solving is key, even at a young age, so that we can build a strong foundation on which children can grow into confident, capable leaders.

2. Foreign Language

All students at Affin Schools are immersed in French language courses, whether it is a student's native language or his or her second language. Courses are conducted primarily in English language to allow students to focus on listening and speaking skills. Reading comprehensions, structural recognition, and writing skills are developed along with cultural topics. Affin Schools is proud to offer advanced English K-8.

3. Science

Our science curriculum is unmatched! At Affin Schools, our students are taught science by a certified science teacher in a separate classroom with lab capabilities, providing our students with a fully immersed experience in grade levels 3-8. All students K-8, participate in Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STREAM) instruction with an emphasis on Problem Based Learning in order to challenge our students to work collaboratively and creatively.

4. Technology

With the ever-growing demands of technology in the 21st century, we feel it is imperative that our students embrace technology within their everyday education. Our elementary school students use technology whenever possible and incorporate smart boards, iPads, and laptops into their everyday learning.

Our Middle School Program

At Affin Schools, our middle school program is rigorous, yet attainable. By the time your children leave middle school, they will have gained an in-depth knowledge of the core curriculum.

1. Academics

In 6th-8th grade level, our students grow not only in academics, but in faith and social responsibility as well. Our middle school program is designed to provide our students with specific instruction and activities that help prepare them for the transition into high school. Social studies, language arts, mathematics (including advanced math courses), science, foreign language, and religion are at the core of our middle school academics program.

2. Foreign Language

Foreign language plays a key role in Affin Schools education. Students learn to respect other cultures and improve their critical thinking, problem solving, and listening skills. As they get older, Affin Schools students experience a more complex and rigorous French curriculum with our Advanced French classes.

3. Science

As a STREAM-focused school, we place great emphasis on our science program for all students. In middle school, science is taught in a separate classroom by a certified science teacher. Sixth graders learn earth science, seventh graders learn life science, and eighth graders learn physical science. Our classroom is lab equipped, meaning that all students get hands-on experience that helps them retain information and prepares them for high school.

4. Technology

At Affin Schools, we take a technology-forward approach to education. Affin Schools is committed to the integration of technology throughout the educational process. All grade levels utilize computers on a daily basis as part of their basic instruction, additionally grades levels 3-8 have a one-to-one iPad. Each classroom has iPads, computers with Internet access, an interactive whiteboard or large screen TV, projector, and an Apple TV system. Technology is also infused into daily lessons.

Dur Academics

We provide students with a rigorous, enriching education that helps them grow spiritually, academically, and emotionally. Through our curriculum, students gain a strong understanding of mathematics, reading, art, social studies, science, and French language, and are prepared for success in college and beyond. From social studies to visual arts and to athletics, our faith is present in all that we do, and students grow spiritually and deepen their relationship with God.

1. After-School Care

Our after-school care program partners with parents to take care of their children beyond the school day and runs until 6. OOpm daily. At after-school care, students have several options: they can spend time with friends, get exercise on the playground, or focus on their studies and complete homework.

9. Technology

Fluency in technology is a large part of every student's future. To help prepare them for the society of the future, we incorporate iPads, Apple TVs, and Mimio response systems into classrooms to give students more exposure to, and familiarity with technology.

Training Requirement:

All instructional personnel and administrators are required as a condition of employment to complete training on these standards of ethical conduct and they must be Virtus trained and fingerprinted.

Reporting Misconduct by Instructional Personnel and Administrators:

All employees and administrators have an obligation to report misconduct by instructional personnel and school administrators which affects the health, safety, or welfare of students. Examples of misconduct include obscene language, drug and alcohol use, disparaging comments, prejudice or bigotry, sexual innuendo, cheating or testing violations, physical aggression, and accepting or offering favours.

Policies and procedures for reporting misconduct by instructional personnel or school administrators which affects the health, safety, or welfare of students are posted in The Employee Handbook and on our website.

Reporting Child Abuse, Abandonment or Neglect:

All employees and agents have an affirmative duty to report actual or suspected cases of child abuse, abandonment, or neglect.

Signs of Physical Abuse:

The child may have unexplained bruises, welts, cuts, or other injuries; broken bones; or burns. A child experiencing physical abuse may seem withdrawn or depressed, seem afraid to go home or may run away, shy away from physical contact, be aggressive, or wear inappropriate clothing to hide injuries.

Signs of Sexual Abuse:

The child may have torn, stained or bloody underwear, trouble walking or sitting, pain or itching in genital area, or a sexually transmitted disease. A child experiencing sexual abuse may have unusual knowledge of sex, or act seductively, fear a particular person, seem withdrawn or depressed, gain or lose weight suddenly, shy away from physical contact, or run away from home.

Signs of Neglect:

The child may have unattended medical needs, little or no supervision at home, poor hygiene or appear underweight. A child experiencing neglect may be frequently tired or hungry, steal food, or appear overly needy for adult attention.

Patterns of Abuse:

Serious abuse usually involves a combination of factors. While a single sign may not be significant, a pattern of physical or behavioural signs is a serious indicator and should be reported.
